INSTRUCTIONS FOR MAIL-IN REGISTRANTS AND FIRST-TIME VOTERS

If you registered to vote by mail after January 1, 2003, did not submit a copy of identification with the application, or did not provide identification to the municipal clerk before election day and are voting in an election for federal office for the first time in this municipality,

YOU ARE REQUIRED TO:

Present to the election inspectors before being allowed to vote:

➤ A current and valid photo I.D. that shows your name,

OR

➤ One of the following that shows your name and current address in the municipality in which you are offering to vote:

a current utility bill,
a bank statement,
a government check,
a pay check, or
a government document.

If you do not present the required form of identification, you may follow the procedures for registering to vote on Election Day or you may vote a provisional ballot.
