**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 208-1 OF THE CITY OF JEFFERSON MUNICIPAL CODE TO ALLOW THE CARRYING OF FIREARMS PER WISCONSIN'S NEW CONCEALED CARRY LAW**

**CITY OF JEFFERSON  
ORDINANCE #18-11**

**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 208-1 OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF JEFFERSON TO ALLOW THE CARRYING OF FIREARMS PER WISCONSIN'S NEW CONCEALED CARRY LAW**

**Section 1.** WHEREAS, the City Code currently prohibits any person from carrying an uncased loaded firearm within the municipal boundaries.

WHEREAS, 2011 Wisconsin Act 35 expressly allows a certified individual to carry a concealed loaded firearm.

**Section 2.** Section 208-1 is hereafter amended to be consistent with state law:

**§ 208-1. Discharging ~~and carrying~~ firearms; hunting.**

No person, except a sheriff, constable, police officer, or his deputies, shall fire or discharge any firearm, rifle, or spring or air gun of any description within the City. ~~or have any firearm, rifle, or spring or air gun in his possession or under his control unless it is unloaded and knocked down or enclosed within a carrying case or other suitable container,~~ Provided that this section shall not prevent the maintenance and use of duly supervised rifle or pistol ranges or shooting galleries authorized by the Common Council, or the firing or discharging of BB guns upon private premises by persons over 16 or under the direct personal supervision of a parent or guardian. This section shall prohibit hunting within the City, provided that the Chief of Police may issue written permits to owners or occupants of

private premises if he finds such privileges necessary for the protection of life or property and subject to such safeguards as he may impose for the safety of lives and property of other persons within the City.

**Section 3.** This ordinance shall take effect after passage and publication as provided by law.

Ald. Krause, seconded by Ald. Horn moved to recommend Ordinance #8-11. On call of the roll, motion carried unanimously.

**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 265-5. B. OF THE CITY OF JEFFERSON MUNICIPAL CODE RELATING TO SPEED LIMITS**

ORDINANCE #19-11**

An Ordinance to Amend 265-5. B. of the City of Jefferson Municipal Code Relating to Speed Limits.

The Common Council, of the City of Jefferson, Jefferson County, Wisconsin hereby ordains as follows:

**Section 1.** Section 265-5 of the City of Jefferson Municipal Code Relating To Speed Limits.

**§ 265-5 Speed Limits**

B. The following streets shall be posted 30 miles per hour:

<u>Name of Street</u>	<u>Location</u>
East South Street	From South Whitewater Avenue to City Limits

**Section 2.** This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force after passage and publication as provided by law and notification and attestation.

**Authorizing City Administrator to contract for consulting engineer services during City Engineer Weiss's Family Medical Leave of Absence**

**WHEREAS**, City Engineer Weiss will begin a Family Medical Leave of Absence in January 2012; and

**WHEREAS**, the length of duration of Ms. Weiss's leave of absence is anticipated to be 12 weeks; and

**WHEREAS**, the Personnel Committee has recognized the vital and critical importance of the City Engineer Position and is recommending that interim engineering services be provided during Ms. Weiss's leave of absence; and

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, by the Common Council of the City of Jefferson, Wisconsin that it herein authorizes the City Administrator to contract with Town and Country Engineering, Inc. for interim engineering services during the period of

Ms. Weiss's leave of absence. Said engineering services are to be provided on an approximately 18 hours a week basis at a cost estimated to be \$80 to \$90 per hour.

Ald. Horn, seconded by Ald. Brandel moved to recommend Resolution No. 74. On call of the roll, motion carried unanimously.

**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING APPOINTMENT OF INTERIM PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT WORKING FOREMAN**

**Authorizing Appointment of Interim Public Works Department Working Foreman**

**WHEREAS**, after many years of dedicated service to the City of Jefferson, Public Works Department Foreman Robert Haas will retire on or about December 27, 2011; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Jefferson has determined that the Foreman Position is an important and necessary position in the Department of Public Works; and

**WHEREAS**, the Personnel Committee has determined that the Foreman Position vacancy should be filled upon the retirement of Mr. Haas; and

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, by the Common Council of the City of Jefferson, Wisconsin that Public Works Department Crew Chief Roger Kutz be appointed to the Public Works Department Foreman Position on an interim basis upon the retirement of Mr. Haas. The length and duration of the interim appointment shall be subject to the discretion of the Common Council; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the hourly wage or rate of pay for the Interim Public Works Department Forman Position shall be \$24.39.

Ald. Carnes, seconded by Ald. Horn moved to recommend Resolution No. 75. On call of the roll, motion carried unanimously.

Ald. Carnes, seconded by Ald. Brandel moved to adjourn to Closed Session Pursuant to Section 19.85(1)(e) of the State of Wisconsin State Statutes to discuss Bids Received for Sections Two and Three of the River Walk Project and Development Agreement with Riverfront Rentals, LLC. On call of the roll, motion carried unanimously.

Ald. Carnes, seconded by Ald. Horn moved to reconvene to open session. On call of the roll, motion carried unanimously.

Ald. Peachey, seconded by Ald. Carnes moved to adjourn the October 18, 2011 meeting of the City of Jefferson Common Council. Motion carried unanimously.
