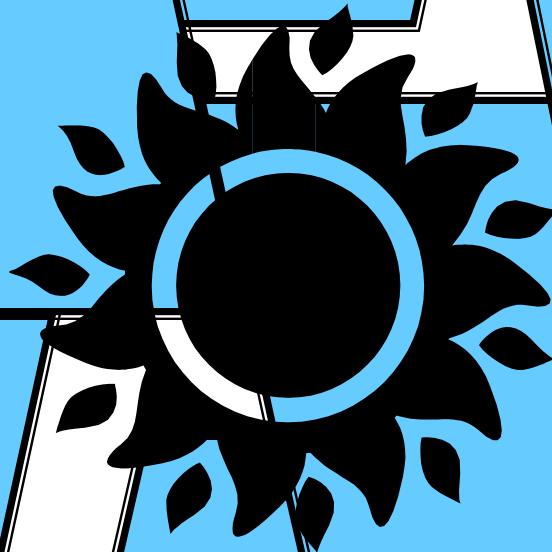

DEPARTMENT POLICIES

Residency

A resident for registration purposes is anyone who lives within the Jefferson School District. Any person residing outside the District boundaries will be considered a non-resident and assessed an additional 25% fee.

Fee Assistance Scholarship Program

Through the generous donations of several local service groups, and businesses a Scholarship Program is available to participants unable to pay fees. Confidential applications are available at the Department. The applicant may be granted a 50% reduction in fee or payment plan at the discretion of the Committee.

Insurance Coverage

Please recognize that neither the Jefferson Park & Recreation Department nor the Jefferson School District carries medical or hospital insurance for injuries or illness participants may sustain in programs. All persons participating in department sponsored activities must provide their own insurance and assume risk of all injuries. The department will not be liable for personal or liabilities of accidents.

Satisfaction Guarantee Credit/Refund Policy

It is our intent to provide recreation programs that meet your expectations of a meaningful leisure time experience. If you are not satisfied, a Credit or Refund, whichever the registrant prefers, will be issued on a prorated basis for cancellation of classes and/or general inability to participate.

Cancellations

The Jefferson Park & Recreation Department reserves the right to cancel, postpone, or combine classes due to insufficient enrollment. All cancellations due to weather and/or facility conditions will be made as soon as possible. Team captains should call after 4:00 p.m. and notify their team members.

School District Cooperation

The Jefferson Parks & Recreation Department would like to thank the Jefferson School District for their support and cooperation with facility scheduling. The extra time and energy from secretaries, custodians, teachers and principals is greatly appreciated.

No Smoking/Alcohol Use Policy

A reminder to program participants: The use of all tobacco products or drinking of alcoholic beverages on premises owned by the Jefferson School District is prohibited by State Law. Your cooperation in upholding this law is necessary.

Lost/Stolen Items

The department is not responsible for personal equipment, clothes, etc. that are lost or stolen during participation in any sponsored activity. However, please contact our office concerning lost items as many times they are turned in by others.

General Registration Details

All registrations will be taken on a first come, first serve basis. Registration forms are found in schools, the Recreation Dept. office and online at www.jeffersonwis.com All forms must be returned to the Recreation Dept. office along with the fee on or before the deadline date.

Registration Deadline

Deadlines are used as a tool to determine whether there is enough interest in a class/activity. Nothing cancels a good class quicker than everyone waiting until the last minute to register. If there are not enough registrations by a the deadline, the course may be canceled.

Participant Publicity Acknowledgement

Our department reserves the right to utilize photos and the names of participants for publicity purposes. Participants desiring their names and/or photos not be used for publicity purposes must notify the department in writing at the time of registration.

3 Ways to Register

WALK-IN You may register in person Monday through Friday from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. at the Parks, Recreation & Forestry Department office, 317 South Main Street.

MAIL-IN Send completed form with check made payable to: *City of Jefferson*. You will receive no notification unless class is filled or canceled.

24- HOUR DROP BOX Simply drop off your registration in our Drop Box located on the outside of the East Dodge Street entrance. It is accessible 24 hours each day and is emptied Monday through Friday.

Late Fee

Any registration received after the deadline date is classified as late. The Recreation Supervisor will determine acceptance of the late registration. If accepted, a late fee of \$5.00 will be assessed.

Returned Checks

If your payment is returned by your bank, we will charge an NSF fee of \$50. Each returned check will be presented to the bank no more than two times in an effort to obtain payment. City of Jefferson is not responsible for any additional fees charged by your bank.

TRIBUTE TREE PROGRAM A TRIBUTE THAT GROWS



The purpose of this program is to encourage the purchase of trees as a means of gifting or paying tribute to individuals, groups, or occasions, such as births, anniversaries, retirements, graduations, weddings, holidays, and memorials.

Citizens and businesses participating in the program not only leave a living, growing legacy for future generations, they assist in beautifying the City and adding to the benefits of the Urban Forest. The City will purchase, deliver, and plant each tree. A plaque will be purchased and installed with your custom message for trees planted in a City Park (no plaque for boulevard trees). Each Tribute Tree cost is \$300. The fee is tax deductible.

PARK SHELTER RESERVATIONS

The Parks, Recreation, & Forestry Department office issues shelter reservations beginning the first working day in January of each year. A reservation fee of \$30/weekdays and \$45/weekends is required. Due to a sharp rise in excessive cleaning required after some rentals, it was necessary to increase the deposit to \$100. The fee, deposit, and signed agreement must be returned to the office within one week of the reservation. Shelters are available at Tensfeldt, Stoppenbach and Riverfront Parks between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 10:00 p.m. Each shelter offers electricity, access to fresh water, dusk to dawn lighting, picnic tables and trash receptacles. ROCK GARDENS

The City of Jefferson Parks Department is excited to announce the first community garden in Jefferson. Rock Gardens will be located along West Riverview Drive at Garity Street on approximately one acre of land recently purchased through the FEMA Flood Recovery Funds. This garden will provide people that may have limited outdoor space an opportunity to grow their own fresh food and enhance their health at the same time.

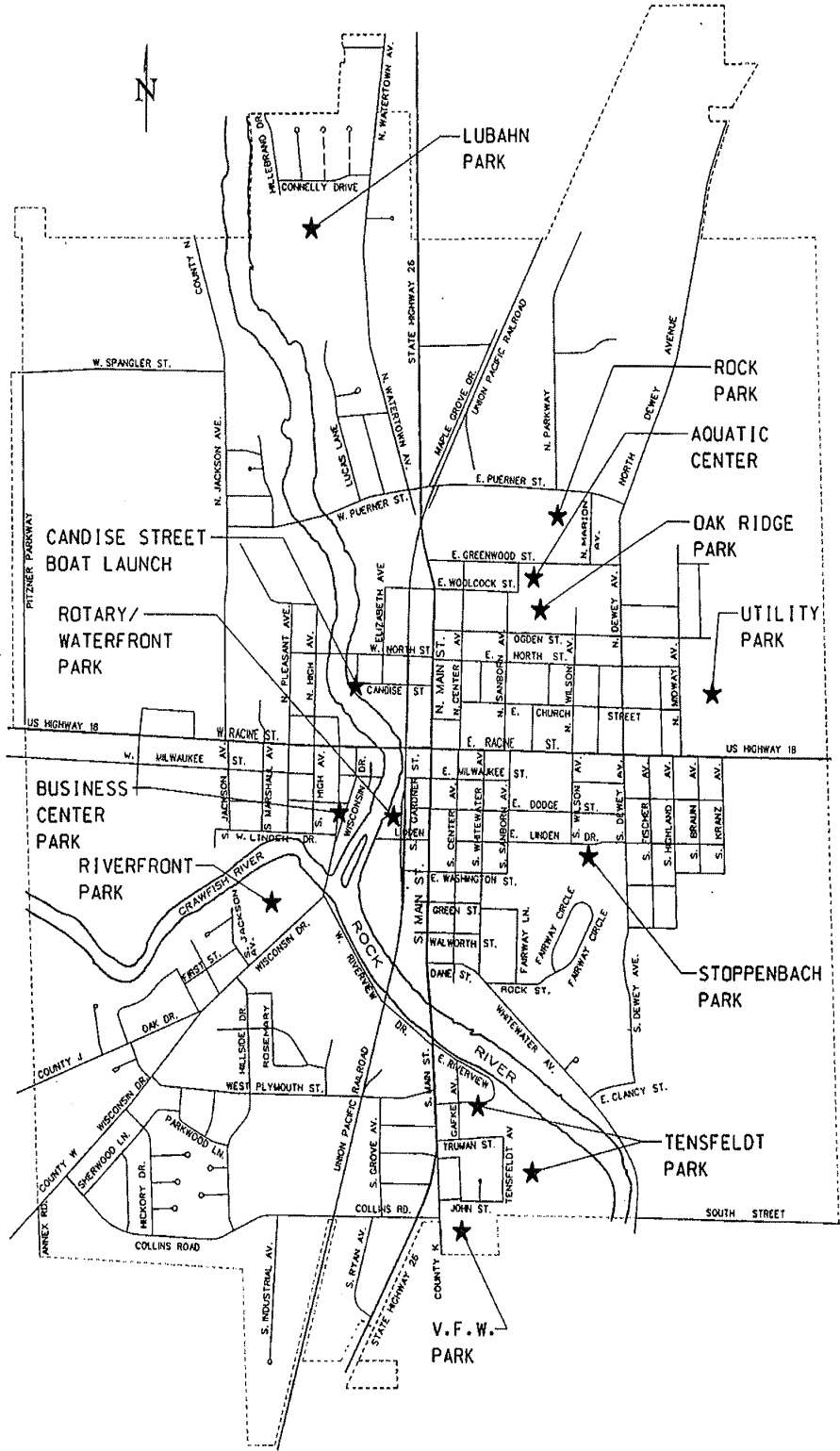
Community gardening provides common ground for people to grow their own vegetables or flowers, and build strong communities. Benefits of gardening include raising fresh produce and saving money, learning new gardening skills, as well as providing a venue for outdoors activity for families and individuals.

Individual plots will be approximately 10 x 10 or 10 x 20 in size. The Parks Department will till the plots prior to the growing season. Compost bins will be available for disposal of weeds that have not gone to seed. A water supply will also be available on site.

If the guidelines are not followed, you will not be allowed to rent a plot for the following year. There is a \$50 deposit which will be returned when the key is returned as well as the plot being clean and no weed notices given

ZOO TO YOU

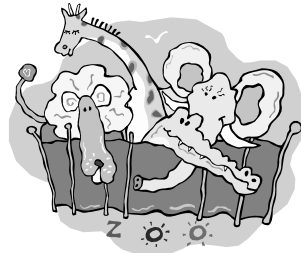

Learn To Swim Program Descriptions

Parent and Child Level 1 (Ages 6 mo. to 2 yrs.): This course is designed to help parents teach their child aquatic orientation and safety skills. One parent or guardian (age 17 or older) must accompany the child in the water. Parents will work one on one, with their child, as instructors assist on a group basis. This class is not designed for children to become accomplished swimmers or even to survive on their own in the water.

Parent and Child Level 2 (Ages 18 mo. To 5 yrs.) : Builds on the skills introduced in Level 1 with participants improving these skills and learning more advanced skills. Parents will accompany children in the water. This class helps children develop self-confidence in the water environment

Level 1 – Introduction to Water Skills: Skills learned in this class will be floating unsupported on front and back, blowing bubbles, independently entering and exiting the water, submerging and holding breath 5 to 8 seconds, kicking in front and back position, alternating arm action and basic water safety rules.

Level 2 – Fundamental Aquatic Skills: Skills learned in this class will be; turning over, back crawl arm action, combined stroke on front and back (5 yards), jumping into chest-deep water, leveling off from a standing position, fundamentals of treading water, introduction to the side stroke and learning how to recognize a swimmer in distress.

Level 3 - Stroke Development: Students learn to coordinate the front crawl and back crawl. They are introduced to the butterfly stroke. Students also learn the head first entry from a sitting or kneeling position.

Level 4 - Stroke Improvement: Students will increase their endurance by swimming familiar strokes (breaststroke, elementary backstroke, butterfly, front crawl and back crawl) for greater distances. They are introduced to the breaststroke, and the basics of turning at a wall. They will dive from a compact or stride position as well as learn additional rules for safe diving.

Level 5 - Stroke Refinement: Students will increase their endurance to the butterfly, open turns, and surface dives. Students perform the front crawl, back crawl, and sidestroke for increased distances.

Level 6: Students develop considerable endurance by the end of this course and are introduced to additional turns as well as the pike and tuck surface dives. Students have the opportunity to work on lifeguard readiness skills, Personal Water Safety & fitness swimmer skills. Each participant will decide which section they would like to learn.
